Father Joseph K. Bill, Vincentian priest, founder and beloved preacher of the “Total Person Therapy of Jesus Christ,” passed away March 14, 2008. Fr. Bill was preaching a Popular Mission in Gulu, Uganda to 300,000 people, when he experienced pain in his arm. In love he kept to his complete schedule including his last talk Wednesday night on peace, forgiveness, and reconciliation.

At the funeral, Father Bill was given the highest honors possible for his service to the people he so loved. He is laid to rest inside the Miraculous Medal Shrine in Entebbe, Uganda, which was built under his direction. All present at his funeral witnessed a spectacular miracle of the sun, as though all of Heaven was welcoming him home. This Shrine is now a great place of pilgrimage and as Fr. Bill spoke of on his retreats, surely someday the Pope will come to pray!

Already Fr. Bill has kept to his word, “I will do even more for everyone after I die”, for the first miracle has taken place through Fr. Bill’s intercession. Easter Sunday, Christina from Korea prayed for a speedy canonization for Fr. Bill, and asked Blessed Mother what she could do to help. Later that day while praying the rosary, her hearing was restored after 40 years of hearing loss. Thank you Jesus, Praise you Jesus.

Fr. Saji Vadakkemury George (Fr. Anthony) is a Vincentian Priest, whose charism is preaching and teaching. He has been chosen by his superiors to carry on Fr. Bill’s mission of evangelization. Fr. Anthony is a young Priest who, by the inspiration and personal invitation of Fr. Bill, chose to serve in the East African Mission. For the past six years he has been studying and working there, with Fr. Bill as his superior. Spending the last few weeks with Fr. Bill, he received

his final blessing and the gift of having Fr. Bill die in his arms. He has been blessed with the gift of healing.

Fr. Anthony has been preaching retreats and popular missions to thousands who come to hear the Word of God. He preaches with energy, humor, and wisdom.

Are you sick in the mind, body or soul? Are you unhappy, depressed, or angry? In the silence of this retreat, you will encounter Jesus as the healer.
